Engler is on the board of **Northwest Airlines** and Munder Capital Management, a subsidiary of **Comerica Bank**.



DOUGLAS STEENLAND Prior to **Northwest Airlines** filing for bankruptcy, Steenland dumped company stock worth millions of dollars. Recently, he signed a compensation agreement with the company guaranteeing him a pension plan that will provide annual payments of at least \$947,000. President & CEO Steenland's compensation for 2004 was \$4,421,480.

It's the company's way, or else."

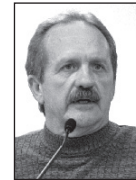
